

LIVING DIVANI AT THE NEW PORRO HK SHOWROOM

Living Divani's overseas visibility is constantly increasing. The firm, reference point on the furniture design scene due to the perfection, harmonious proportions and sense of understated luxury of its upholstery, now reaffirms its position in **Asia** with an important display at **PORRO HK**, the new **Porro** showroom in **Hong Kong**.

The showroom will be officially inaugurated on 28 February, with the participation of architect Piero Lissoni, who is art director and designer for both brands.

Set on two storeys, for a total of 700 m², it is structured like a large, contemporary, sophisticated house, in which the furniture and accessories from Living Divani complete and complement the Porro range.

Four living areas, three dining spaces, two bedrooms and a wardrobe flow seamlessly from one into the other, in a circuit featuring dark grey walls, luxurious woods, and neutral-coloured furniture with elegant green highlights, injecting a touch of nature into one of the world's most densely-populated spaces.

The Living Divani selection focuses on iconic pieces by **Piero Lissoni**, accompanied by a number of complements to complete the brand's world of formal purity and designed in recent years by **Studio Juju**, **Giopato & Coombes**, **David Lopez Quincoces**, **Victor Carrasco**, **Victor Vasilev**, and **Harry&Camila**.

Greeting visitors as they enter is **Ile Club** sofa: large, soft cushions supported effortlessly and weightlessly by the metal frame below. Capturing the eye in the central living area is **Extrasoft**, the informal-looking modular sofa that offers comfortable seats, joined together to create regular geometrical forms. The third daytime space features **Rod XL** sofa and **Rod** armchairs, which offer the possibility of choosing different coverings for the shell and cushions, creating striking two-tone effects and captivating combinations of different materials. A small stopping space focuses on the stylized shapes of **Rabbit & the Tortoise Collection** coffee tables, which can be arranged so as to create flow within their space, decorating the home with cheerful elegance.

On the first floor, a pleasant relaxation area combines **Kiru** easy chairs, with their broad, soft forms, and refined, distinctive sartorial details in the rear, with **Family Lounge**. The bedroom features **Café** chairs with their elegant woven covering, while the walk-in wardrobe includes **Track** bench, with its essential, regular shapes and stunning finishes. Finally, the fourth living space opts for **NeoWall** sofa, a seating system that gives priority to the proportions of the individual elements and their overall harmony, **Gray** easy chairs with their empty geometric shapes in dark wood, and **Strato** coffee tables, with their multiple contoured tops assembled by a central spacer ring.

Completing the scene, **B2** coffee table, reminiscent of a miniature architectural complex, with different perspectives from each different viewpoint, and the creations of the Living Divani **Carpet Collection**, a collection of luxurious rugs all featuring the masterly use of precious fabrics and harmonious shapes and colours.
