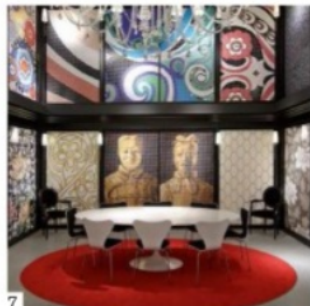
The showroom, to a concept by Antonio Citterio and project by Studio Tronconi, is set in The Whitman, an elegant neo-Georgian building from 1924.

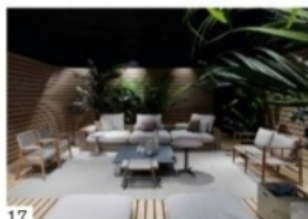
Davide Groppi lamps arrived in the USA with the opening of Spazio Esperienze in 2023.
