

PREVIEW OF THE NEW OUTDOOR COLLECTION 2025 Living Divani Gallery: new horizons for the outdoors

Living Divani Gallery renews its spaces, renovating the Milanese showroom into a visual narrative where design and research meet. The new 2025 outdoor proposals, alongside a selection of iconic pieces, turn the environment/ambience into a journey through the world of **Living Divani**.

The windows become a stage for the brand's creativity, a place where artistic and projectual vision takes shape through carefully curated and refined compositions. In the background, suspended fabrics on the walls evoke the patterns of sky and clouds, creating an ethereal atmosphere that enhances the sense of an "En Plein Air" corner—like a suspended garden in the heart of the city. Within the greenery of plants and the delicate fragrance of flowers, the setting turns into poetry. The open-air ambiance reflects and expands, extending the feeling of freedom and making the scene enchanting. A place where the boundary between inside and outside dissolves, creating a captivating experience.

Among the highlights, **Balestro24 sofa**, signed by **Piero Lissoni**, is reimagined for external use in two fascinating dresses. The first features backrests and armrests covered in soft-touch, weather-resistant/ weather-proof fabrics. The second showcases an intricate rope weaving, combining artisanal charm with modern design, paired with bases available in three color shades. The result is a perfect balance between aesthetics and functionality, seamlessly interacting with the contiguous landscape.

The **Kasumi collection**, by **Mist-o**, expands with new elements that celebrate the elegance of nature and the harmony of outdoor spaces. Alongside the armchair, the **Kasumi settee** debuts, presenting fluid lines that invite relaxation while blending effortlessly with its surroundings. Completing the collection are the **Kasumi low tables**, whose organic and delicate shapes are inspired by natural elements. Their sophisticated structure is characterized by a distinctive recess/ notch—a detail that adds dynamism and depth, symbolizing the pursuit of balance between form and function.

In the area overlooking **Via Visconti di Modrone**, the display explores a dialogue between past and present, where catalogue products meet contemporary proposals. The **Notes table**, with its porcelain stoneware top, is paired with the **Maja D chair**, presented with an elegant performing bouclé upholstery. Following this, the **Agra sofa and daybed** family evoke a timeless aesthetic, where neoclassical grace fuses with oriental charm.

The central corridor of the showroom, with its distinctive "telescope-like" configuration, becomes a scenic element that enriches perspectives and architecture, offering a dynamic experience culminating in the light well area. Here, the Extrasoft sofa, one of the collection's most iconic pieces, takes centre stage. The Cuoietto hide-upholstered version highlights its bold character, alongside the Gray armchair, another signature piece by Piero Lissoni.

Descending to the lower floor, the atmosphere shifts, becoming more intimate and welcoming, evoking the brand's domestic dimension. The **Lorentz sofa**, by **David Lopez Quincoces**, stands out in its corner- configuration for its modularity and enveloping comfort. Enhancing the space is the **Kasumi armchair** in its indoor version, featuring a charcoal-dyed ash frame and hide weaving, showcasing meticulous artisanal craftsmanship.

In the adjacent area, the **Graft table**, reinterpreted in a round version, makes a statement with its minimalist and sophisticated style. Around it, the **Era chairs** blend impeccably, echoing the finishes of the **Railway storage unit**. Designed by **Giacomo Moor**, this piece alternates open and closed compartments in a play of proportions and essentiality.
